About William L. Ivey



William L. Ivey served as the President and Chief Executive Officer of Richland Memorial Hospital (now Prisma Health Richland) from 1975 until his retirement in 1992. His experience – a combination of academics, patient services, hospital administration and comprehensive health planning services – and his personal and professional commitment to affordable, quality health care for everyone enabled him to set a course for Richland Memorial, increasing its size and services to the state while making it a recognized leader in health care.

Upon his retirement, donors to the then Richland Memorial Hospital Foundation created an endowment to support educational initiatives that would develop solutions to health problems in which South Carolina ranks below the national average in outcomes. This endowment is now managed by Prisma Health Midlands Foundation.

William L. Ivey Scholarship Information

The William L. Ivey endowment provides a unique scholarship opportunity for professional development for Prisma Health Richland team members. The scholarship will provide conference registration, hotel accommodations and travel to one of the Institute for Healthcare Improvement (IHI) national or international conferences with the expectation that knowledge gained will be shared with others at Prisma Health and will result in first-hand expertise that will be a tremendous asset to Prisma Health.

Upon returning from the IHI conference, scholarship recipients will present their findings to the Prisma Health Richland Executive Leadership Team and/or the Quality and Patient Safety Committee, the Harm Elimination Team, colleagues, other team members and other appropriate committees.

- As long as resources are available, this scholarship will be awarded at the sole discretion of the William L. Ivey Scholarship Selection Committee.
- Applicant must be a full-time or part-time team member reporting up through Prisma Health Richland chain of command. Applicant must have worked for Prisma Health Richland for at least two years at time of application. Applicant must be a team member in good standing as verified by a Human Resource review of personnel file. This process is CONFIDENTIAL and will be initiated by the COO's office, not the applicant.
- Applicant must submit one letter of recommendation from supervisor. Letters should be in narrative format and speak to the worthiness and attributes that qualify applicant for consideration of this scholarship. Letters should be signed by the writer and submitted in pdf format via email to Paulette.Sessions@PrismaHealth.org by stated deadline.
- A recipient is eligible to receive support of up to \$5,000. Scholarship funds may not be retroactively applied and are intended to support 2025-2026 IHI conference registration and travel expenses. When timing allows, recipients must take advantage of Early Bird Registration pricing.
- Scholarship recipients will be required to present a summary of their conference attendance and findings to the Prisma Health Richland COO and leadership team.

Scholarship Recipient Selection

Following the Scholarship Committee's recommendation and the COO's approval, a letter will be sent to each individual recipient.

Scholarship recipients may apply the monetary award to accommodations, registration, and transportation prior to the date of the applicable IHI conference. Upon return to Prisma Health Richland, receipts may be submitted to the PHR Administration office for reimbursement for all allowable expenses: local transportation (taxi, bus, train, etc.); meals (three per day); any non-alcoholic beverages.

Scholarship Pay Back

Each applicant is required to sign a disclaimer form prior to receipt of any scholarship monies. This agreement is only enforced if the requirements of the scholarship are not met. If for some reason the scholarship recipient encounters difficulty in complying with the herein stated requirements, it is important to notify the PHR Administration office as soon as possible.

Please note: Any costs that exceed scholarship amount are the responsibility of award recipient. This includes travel, lodging, food expenses, etc.
